IMPORTANT 2025 CAMP INFORMATION FOR LEADERS

Please read the following information and review the camp policies.

CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT: Registration on the first day of camp is from **1pm - 4:30pm**. When you arrive at camp, please come to located the **Rain Tree Auditorium**. Once you arrive to the front gate, security will assist with directions to the Rain Tree Auditorium. Dinner will be served on the first day at 6:00PM. Student orientation will begin at 5PM. Check-out time on the last day of camp is 9AM with Breakfast at 8:00am.

CAMP STAFF AGE: Kids Camp Leaders must be 17+. Youth Camp Leaders must be 20+. No exceptions.

BACKGROUND SCREENING: For anyone who registers as Camp Leaders, there is a state law that requires background screening of all Camp Leaders. Camp Leaders will **NOT** be allowed to attend camp until they are cleared by a completed background screen. Potential Camp Leaders will need to register online at www.proofchurch.org/lpy. Once registered an email will be sent to them from Proof Church to do a confidential background check. The church in which the Camp Leader is representing will be responsible to pay to have the screening performed. Results will then be forwarded to Proof Church. **If the church you are coming to camp with has a background report for you, we can accept a copy of that report as long its is an up to date report.

MEALS: Mealtimes will be at 8AM, 12:00PM, and 6:00PM. The Shack (snack bar) will be open 3 times a day in case campers would like some candy or sodas, so you may choose to bring \$5-\$10 per day for concessions. No lunch will be served on Monday or Friday.

CAMP REGISTRATION FEES: The price of camp includes: registration, tuition, lodging, meals. If the registration process is not completed prior to the early deadline, add \$50 for the full price. There will be no extensions. We strongly recommend making reservation prior to the early registration deadline. There is limited space at our facility, and the state will not permit an overflow position. The only way to guarantee your space is to pre-register. Any transfer of funds – other than the deposit - from one stude to another must be done in advance and not on-site.

LEADER-TO-CAMPER RATIO: Due to the large number of campers that attend Proof Church, inc. Camps every summer, all churches that bring groups of more than five are expected to provide staff to help assist with the students. However, if the Leader to Camper ratio is less than 1:5, then a church will be asked to drop Leaders.

PRE-REGISTRATION: No phone registrations or partial registrations will be accepted. Only a deposit with a completed online registration and camper consent & agreement form will hold a spot. Payment must be made online at the proofchurch.org/lpy registration or held spots may be dropped. Walk-ins may be accepted based on our capacity. Students or groups registering by the early registration deadline must pay the correct deposit amount to be eligible for the early registration pricing.

REFUNDS: If a student is unable to attend camp after they have registered, please notify us as soon as possible. Due to programming costs, **refunds are no longer available**. However, prior to the drop date deadlines, all payments will be applied to the total balance due upon final payment. After the drop date deadlines, groups will be held liable for the full cost of the unused spots. If we are able to resell the unused spots, then groups will only lose their non-refundable deposits.

HOUSING: All Leaders will be assigned to dormitory style rooms before arriving on the campgrounds on a first come first serve basis. Dormitory rooms will separated by biological sex. Add-ons cannot be guaranteed to be housed with their group. We will do our best to accommodate housing requests, but with **NO GUARANTEES!** If the camp sells out you will be offered another week to attend, if available. If all the camps sell out, there may be an opportunity to stay at a local hotel. Or, if you are support staff you may be asked to move off of the campground to a local hotel to free a bed for a student. Hotel options are only available if church leadership agrees and transportation is present.

NON-CAMPER POLICY: Proof Church summer camps are **CLOSED** camps. All camp activities including evening services are open only to registered campers and staff. Any child, student or adult violating this policy will be asked to leave the grounds.

LOST & FOUND: Any lost and found items left on grounds after the conclusion of camp will be held for one month. If not claimed during that time period, they will be given away. Items will be shipped back to their owners at their owners' expense.

CAMP PROPERTY DAMAGE: Charges for items broken/damaged during camp will be billed to all parties/individuals involved.

CAMP POLICIES & RULES: By registering for camp, you agree to abide by all rules set forth by Proof Church, Inc., Lake Yale Baptist Conference Center, and Proof Church Youth Pastor. Policies are given as guidelines for every camper to follow. This code of conduct has been established for your student's protection and the benefit of every person present. The lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect for property, or an unwholesome attitude on the part of any camper will result in expulsion from camp. The expense of transporting the expelled camper(s) home from camp is the responsibility of the parents/guardians.

ATTITUDE / BEHAVIOR

- We should strive at all times to conduct ourselves as Christians with proper consideration shown for others.
- Campers must show respect for leaders, staff, and camp property.
- All leaders are authorized to maintain order anywhere on the grounds.
- No public displays of affection.
- Profanity is not allowed.
- No excessive practical joking. Hazing and destruction of property will result in dismissal from the camp.
- Attendance at all scheduled activities is compulsory.
- No one may leave the campgrounds at any time.
- Sneaking off with someone is grounds for dismissal.
- During services and teaching times, no hoods (hoodies) are allowed to cover heads.
- No personal electronic devices are allowed! This includes iPods, MP3s, cameras, etc. Cell phones may be used in the parking lot during free time but are otherwise off-limits.
- No fireworks, firearms, knives, tobacco, alcohol, drugs, Orby guns, Air-soft guns, paintball guns, or pets will be allowed on the grounds. Except by authorized and approved personnel.
- No improper reading materials such as pornography, erotic novels, violence, or anything in violation camp policies.
- We reserve the right to inspect the contents of all personal belongings, locked or unlocked.
- For the comfort of those around you, please observe habits of personal cleanliness. Take a daily shower!

VEHICLES / GOLF CARTS

- Campers are not allowed to use leader vehicles.
- Campers are not allowed to ride on or drive golf carts. If caught on a cart, you will be subject to immediate dismissal.
- If you have a car parked on the property, you must turn in your keys to your leader or the camp dean for the entirety.

DORMS

- Campers must stay in their assigned dorm room. Do not hang out in other dorm rooms.
- Campers are not allowed to stay in the dorm room for any reason during activities (if sick, go to First Aid).
- Campers are not allowed in the opposite biological sex dorm area. (This is a Christian camp and biological sex is decided according to biblical principles outlined in our bylaws of the Assemblies of God)
- Only 1 camper per bunk. No exceptions!
- Only 1 camper per shower at a time. No exceptions!
- Keep dorm room picked up. Nothing should be blocking aisle ways or doorways.
- Keep bathrooms picked up by wiping the sink after use and properly disposing of your trash.
- No food or drinks are allowed in the dorm rooms.
- Texting pictures from dorm rooms is prohibited.
- Campers must stay in dorm rooms after lights out and must stay there until the wake-up call.
- Leaving the dorm after lights-out is grounds for dismissal.
- Zero tolerance for bullying. There is an immediate dismissal of students bullying other students.

CAFETERIA

- Clean up after yourself. Take your tray and trash to the designated areas.
- No saving places in the cafeteria line.
- Respectfully allow leaders to cut to the front of the line.
- No food or cafeteria items are to be taken from the cafeteria.
- Shoes must be worn at all times in the cafeteria.
- No wet clothing in the cafeteria.

POOL

- You must wear proper clothing: towel, shirts, and shoes are required to walk to and from the pool area.
- No excessive horseplay.
- You must shower before entering the pool.
- No food or drinks in the pool area
- No pool access if covered in paint from the paint war.

SNACK SHACK / OUTDOOR RECREATION BUILDING

- Keep the Snack Shack area and surrounding outdoor area clean by properly disposing of trash.

CAMPGROUNDS

- Campers must turn all medication into the camp nurse during registration. First aid is accessible 24 hours a day.
- Campers must not enter wooded areas surrounding Masterpiece Gardens due to wildlife and quicksand dangers.
- Campers must not go near Lake Pierce due to the excessive gator population.
- No one is allowed on the dock at any time.
- Visitors are not allowed on the campgrounds.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Bible, Notepad & Pen
- Recreational Clothes
- Gym shoes
- Sleeping bag or twin bed sheets, blanket, pillow
- Towels & Wash Cloths
- Soap, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Shampoo, Hairdryer
- Modest swim wear
- For girls - no exposed mid drifts and low cut swim tops
- For boys - no speedos,
- Spending money for snacks & camp store
- Water Bottle (refillable with name clearly marked)
- Sunscreen & Bug Spray
- Dirty Clothes Bag

Please clearly label all items. Campers are responsible for personal belongings. Proof Church, its affiliates nor sponsors are responsible for lost/ stolen items.

WHAT NOT TO BRING: No electric devices, laptops, video games, Silly String, shaving cream, water guns, water balloons, tape, spray paint products. We encourage you NOT to bring cell phones, iPods, etc. If they are used during the service or planned activities, they will be secured by our staff.

WHAT TO WEAR:

- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- No visible undergarments.
- Shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
- For Girls: No skirts or dresses shorter than 3 inches above the knee. No halter tops or spaghetti straps.
- For Boys: No Muscle shirts that expose your side or abdomen
- No exposed mid drifts or low-cut shirts.
- Apparel may not promote alcohol, tobacco, or inappropriate or sexually suggestive language.
- Tattoos and body piercings must be unobtrusive and of non-controversial content. Some piercings may need to be removed and tattoos covered.
- You must be appropriately covered while walking to and from the pool area. Wear a towel, robe, whatever it takes... Cover up!
